
megan geckler: flagging tape installation for bobble






dimensions: 10ft x 10ft x 8ft


the installation is comprised of a matte black structure measuring 10 feet x 10 feet x 8 feet covered in 1 inch wide segments of flagging tape in blue, green, yellow, red, pink and periwinkle. these pieces are placed on the frame at 90-degree angles, then individually woven in order to create a plaid-patterned, pixelated compilation of color, when studied from the structure's interior, the harsh lighting of the warehouse showroom is diffused into a glowing effect and the observer is instead surrounded by a modern stained glass-like shelter.
