

A Million Things That Make Your Head Spin

American artist Megan Geckler lets us feel what it might be like to step inside a dazzling rainbow at Customs House

Feel what it is like to step inside a dazzling rainbow.

American artist <u>Megan Geckler</u> is bringing her detailed, multicoloured installations to Sydney, and this new work is delivering a 'wow' moment inside one of the city's most historic buildings.

The atrium within Customs House will be home to *A Million Things That Make Your Head Spin*. The hovering, cloud-like form, which gets its name from a line in Australian band <u>The Jungle Giants</u>' track *Don't Know What Else to Do*, is part of Geckler's hyper-colourful, mathematically-based practice using thousands of metres of tape, more commonly used on construction sites.

When diffused sunlight is streaming through the multiple stories of Customs House, intersecting the thousands of colourful ribbons in the giant installation, the result will be like stepping inside a rainbow. And while it is visually arresting from the ground floor, every level of the building will provide a unique view.
